## Minutes of the Regular Bradford Township Meeting 7:00 p.m. Monday May 10, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by John Hass. Midco would work with the township toward future expansion of broadband.

We are not interested in selling the former Blumer property.

The treasurer's report was presented by Brenda Springer. Bryan Hathaway moved to approve and pay the claims. Richard Hansen, seconded, and the motion passed unanimously seconded.

There was discussion of the dam on Long Lake.

There was a request from Lake Francis for placement of a swimming beach sign. The issue was tabled.

Greg Anderson explained the reasons for appointing a county Auditor/Treasurer.
